Qualifications: High School Diploma/GED with 2 years of relevant experience; youth development experience necessary; CYC Certification preferred

Reporting: Specialty Teacher reports to the Site Coordinator & Assistant Site Coordinator

Job Responsibilities:

- Ensure high-quality program services and support to Neu-Life youth.
- Teach and facilitate specialty activities, classes, workshops to youth.
- Evaluates situations (e.g. disciplinary problems, hazardous conditions, etc.)
 for the purpose of taking appropriate action and/or directing to appropriate personnel for resolution.
- Develop and mentor Assistant Teacher(s) and/or other staff to achieve intended objectives.
- Cleans work areas (e.g. classroom, storage, program areas, work tables, etc.) to maintain a safe and orderly environment.
- Assist in the planning, creation, and implementation of special events.
- Participates in various meetings and trainings (e.g. staff development, staff meetings, etc.) to share information and/or improve one's skill/knowledge.
- Supervises all program participants; must monitor and stay at all times with their classes
- Active and appropriate engagement required

 Other duties as assigned by Site Coordinator and/or Assistant Site Coordinator

Special Requirements: This position requires a background check.

Hours: Part-time seasonal; 10-20 hours per week

Salary: \$15-\$25 per hour; based on qualifications
